Town of North Haven, Connecticut

REGULATIONS by the Chief of Police for the Town of North Haven, Connecticut governing the conduct of persons issued a permit to conduct Canvassing, Soliciting or Hawking Activities within the Town of North Haven, Connecticut. A copy of said rules and regulations shall be furnished to each person to whom a permit is issued, at the time that said permit is issued. Any violation of the following regulations or any violation of any Federal Law, State Law or Town Ordinance shall be cause for the suspension and /or revocation of permits issued by the Chief of Police of North Haven, Connecticut.

(A) Said permit holder shall not conduct canvassing, or soliciting activities on Sunday or any National or State Holiday provided for by law.

(B) Solicitors and Canvassers shall go to the front door **ONLY** of a dwelling residence.

(C) Solicitors or Canvassers shall not conduct business before 9:00 A.M. nor after hours of sunset.

(D) Solicitors shall show permit to any such persons so solicited or to any Police Officer on request.

(E) Solicitors shall immediately, without question, vacate any residence or premises of a person so solicited, if the person so solicited indicates that he or she does not wish to engage in business with said Solicitor or Canvasser.

(F) Any person whose license to solicit, canvass or conduct Hawking activities within the Town of North Haven, Connecticut has been revoked by the Chief of Police shall not be eligible for the issuance of a license at any other time.

A person holding a License issued by the Chief of Police of North Haven, Connecticut shall immediately have his or her license suspended by the Chief of Police upon receipt of a complaint about his or her conduct or on a complaint that he or she has violated, any Federal or State law or who has violated any local ordinance shall have said license immediately suspended pending investigation of said complaint by the Chief of Police. If, after such an investigation the Chief of Police determines that said complaint is valid, the person's license which has been suspended shall be revoked and he or she shall not be eligible for the issuance of a license at any other time, in the Town of North Haven, Connecticut.

§ 177-1. License required.

No solicitors, canvassers or hawkers, as defined in § 177-3 of this ordinance, shall engage in any such soliciting, canvassing or hawking activities within the Town of North Haven, Connecticut, without having obtained from the Chief of Police of the Town of North Haven a license therefor as required by this ordinance.
